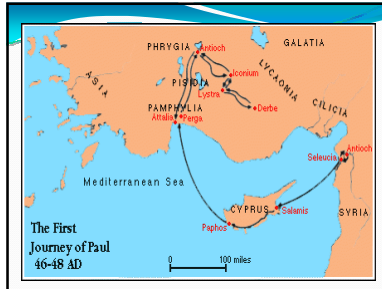


The journey of the gospel
